# Introduction

The pandemic has affected our KF scholars disproportionately. We have had to change our game to accommodate their new needs. From issuing laptops to arranging for internet connectivity, we continue to meet scholars where they are.

While CEG continues to attract top talent from all over Tamil Nadu, it is upto organizations like KF to lend a hand to those hardworking students who have severe financial difficulties. The need continues to far outstrip our capacity. For example, last year alone 72 incoming first year students needed support. We were able to support only 28 of them. This is possible because of good support from CEG1991, CEG1993, CEG2000 batches and CEGAANA. A vast majority of our students come from single-parent families. And about 90% have parents without a college degree (first graduate student in family).

At the Knowledge Foundation, we remain hopeful.

We have seen our efforts make a real difference. The KF scholars you see in this newsletter illustrate the talent, resilience, and grit of the young students we support. The strength they have shown in overcoming obstacles and their go-get-it determination offers us reason for optimism. All but two of our graduates have landed a job. The two have had physical illness to overcome. Many have had more than one job offer. Arivazhakan works in Dubai. Krishnaveni works in Germany. The list of their achievements goes on.

Thank you for your continued support of KF and your commitment to creating hope through education. Your generosity is essential to our work. We cannot do the essential work without you.
